Follow-up matters to the meeting of 21 May 2018

In response to the follow-up matters raised at the captioned Subcommittee meeting, the Government provides the supplementary information as below.

(a) <u>Time lag in making claims</u>

The average time lag between entering Hong Kong (including illegal entry) and making claims by claimants of the 1 743 non-refoulement claims pending screening by the Immigration Department ("ImmD") as at end September 2018 is at <u>Annex</u>.

(b) **Overview of legal aid applications**

The Security Bureau and ImmD do not maintain the relevant statistics on applications made by non-refoulement claimants to the Legal Aid Department for legal aid to lodge judicial review following refusal of their claims or appeals.

(c) **Profile of minor claimants**

As at end September 2018, among the 1 743 non-refoulement claims pending screening by ImmD, 61 claimants are minor. Their nationalities are mainly Indonesian (18%), Filipino (13%), Togolese (10%), Indian (8%), Sri Lankan (8%), Vietnamese (8%), Bangladeshi (7%) and Nigerian (7%).
