Subcommittee on Members' Remuneration and Operating Expenses Reimbursement

Utilization of Members' Operating Expenses Reimbursement

Purpose

This paper provides information on the utilization of Legislative Council ("LegCo") Members' Operating Expenses Reimbursement ("OER").

Background

- 2. It is an established practice for the Subcommittee on Members' Remuneration and OER ("the Subcommittee") to review the remuneration package and expenses reimbursement arrangements for LegCo Members at least one year before the start of a new LegCo term. After the review, any proposals to change the level of remuneration and OER for Members of the new term will be put forward to the Administration for consideration by the Independent Commission on Remuneration for Members of the Executive Council and the Legislature, and Officials under the Political Appointment System of the HKSAR.
- 3. To facilitate the aforesaid review, information on the utilization of Members' operating expenses reimbursement in the Fifth LegCo and the first two reimbursement years of the current term (i.e. from October 2016 to September 2018)¹ is set out in the ensuing paragraphs.

Operating Expenses Reimbursement

(a) Office Operation Expenses Reimbursement

4. The average utilization rates of Office Operation Expenses Reimbursement ("OOER") per Member in the Fifth LegCo and Sixth

The statistics on Members' utilization of operating expenses reimbursement in the current term are calculated based on the claims processed by the LegCo Secretariat up to 1 February 2019.

Further breakdowns according to the method by which Members were returned² and the major categories of expenses are in **Appendix I**.

- 5. In the Fifth LegCo and the first two reimbursement years of the current term, the utilization rates of OOER of 52 Members (about 73.2%) and 31 Members (about 45.6%) respectively were 90% or over. Details of the distribution of utilization rates of OOER are in **Appendix II**.
- 6. It should be noted that starting from the Fifth LegCo, unused entitlement of OOER in one year can be rolled over to the following year(s) until the end of a LegCo term. With such roll-over arrangement, Members have the flexibility to decide whether to reserve more funds for use in one particular year or towards the end of the term provided that the cumulative claims do not exceed the entitlement.

(b) Entertainment and Travelling Expenses Reimbursement

7. The overall average utilization rates of Entertainment and Travelling Expenses Reimbursement ("ETER") per Member in the Fifth LegCo and Sixth LegCo are as follows.

current term, the utilization rates of ETER of 64 Members (about 90.2%) and 62 Members (about 91.2%) respectively were 90% or over. Details of the distribution of utilization rates of ETER are in **Appendix IV**.

(c) Over-ceiling expenses

9. While over-ceiling expenses are not reimbursable, in order to ascertain the total provision required by Members to carry out their LegCo duties, Members are invited to report such expenses to the Secretariat. Expenses in excess of the ceilings for OOER and ETER were submitted by 12 Members in the Fifth LegCo and 7 Members in the first two reimbursement years of the current term. The amounts reported for the Fifth LegCo and the current term range from \$5,000 to \$707,000 and \$221,000 to \$593,000 respectively, with details in **Appendix V**. It should be noted that as over-ceiling expenses are reported on a voluntary basis, the information may not fully reflect the level of resources required by Members for carrying out their duties.

(d) Setting Up and Information Technology Expenses Reimbursement

10. The overall average utilization rates of Setting Up and Information Technology Expenses Reimbursement ("SUITER") per Member in the Fifth LegCo and the first two reimbursement years of the current term are about 73.8% and 43.9% respectively; the utilization rates of 35 Members (about 49.3%) in the Fifth LegCo and 5 Members (about 7.3%) in the current term were 90% or over. Further breakdowns according to the method by which Members were returned and the distribution of utilization rates are in **Appendix VI**.

(e) Winding Up Expenses Reimbursement

11. The overall average utilization rate of Winding Up Expenses Reimbursement (excluding the actual severance payment) per Member in the Fifth LegCo was about 53.9% and the utilization rates of 8 Members (about 29.7%) were 90% or over. Further breakdowns according to the method by which Members were returned and the distribution of utilization rates are in **Appendix VII**.

The utilization rate of SUITER per Member in the first two reimbursement years of the current term (i.e. 1 October 2016 to 30 September 2018) is calculated based on the total amount of claims processed by the LegCo Secretariat up to 1 February 2019 divided by the ceiling of SUITER per term i.e. \$375,000 or \$262,500 (for Members who have claimed setting up expenses in the previous term).

Medical allowance

- 12. The overall average utilization rates of medical allowance per Member in the Fifth LegCo and the first two reimbursement years of the current term (i.e. from 1 October 2016 to 30 September 2018)⁴ are about 54.9% and 63.4% respectively; the utilization rates of 8 Members (about 11.2%) in the Fifth LegCo and 24 Members (about 35.3%) in the current term were 90% or over. Further breakdowns according to the method by which Members were returned and the distribution of utilization rates are in **Appendix VIII**.
- 13. Members may wish to note that starting from the Sixth LegCo, any unused entitlement of medical allowance in one year can be rolled over to the following year until the end of a LegCo term.

14. Members are invited to note the information set out in this paper.
