I. Election of Chairman and Deputy Chairman

(Appendix II to LC Paper No. $\,$ -- Terms of Reference of the Panel CB(1)4/16-17

Election of Chairman

Mr James TO, the member who had the highest precedence among those who joined the Panel, presided over the election of the Chairman of the Panel for the 2016-2017 session.

- 2. <u>Mr James TO</u> invited nominations for the chairmanship of the Panel. Mr WU Chi-wai was nominated by <u>Mr Alvin YEUNG</u> and the nomination was seconded by <u>Mr Andrew WAN</u>. <u>Mr WU Chi-wai</u> accepted the nomination.
- 3. There being no other nominations, Mr WU Chi-wai was declared Chairman of the Panel for the 2016-2017 session.

Election of Deputy Chairman

4. <u>Mr WU Chi-wai</u> took the chair and invited nominations for the deputy chairmanship for the 2016-2017 session. Mr SHIU Ka-fai was nominated by <u>Ir Dr LO Wai-kwok</u> and the nomination was seconded by <u>Mr Steven HO</u>. <u>Mr SHIU Ka-fai</u> accepted the nomination and declared that he was a member of the Business Facilitation Advisory Committee, a Government advisory committee relevant to the Panel. There being no other nominations, Mr SHIU Ka-fai was declared Deputy Chairman of the Panel for the 2016-2017 session.

II. Schedule of meetings for the 2016-2017 session

- 5. <u>Members</u> noted the proposed schedule of regular meetings of the Panel for the 2016-2017 session, which was tabled at the meeting.
- 6. <u>Members</u> agreed that future regular meetings of the Panel for the 2016-2017 session would be held on the third Tuesday of each month at 2:30 pm, except for the meeting in January 2017. As the Chief Executive would deliver his Policy Address on 18 January 2017, <u>members</u> agreed that the regular Panel meeting cum Policy briefing in January 2017 would be rescheduled from 17 January 2017 to Wednesday, 25 January 2017, at 2:30 pm.

Regular Panel meeting on 15 November 2016

- 7. <u>Members</u> agreed that the Panel would discuss the following items proposed by the Administration at the regular meeting to be held on Tuesday, 15 November 2016, at 2:30 pm
 - (a) Legislative proposal to expand the scope of tax deduction for capital expenditure incurred for the purchase of intellectual property rights; and
 - (b) Proposal for creating a permanent Assistant Director of Intellectual Property (Patents) (DL2) post to follow through patent reform in Hong Kong.

<u>Items for discussion at future meetings</u>

8. <u>The Chairman</u> referred to the list of issues suggested to be considered in the 2016-2017 session ("the List") tabled at the meeting, and invited members to note the List and propose other discussion items, if any.

Diversified development of industries

9. <u>Dr Helena WONG</u> requested the Administration to brief the Panel on the latest development of the Government's initiatives to promote the diversified development of industries in Hong Kong. It was also suggested that members of the Panel on Economic Development should be invited to attend the relevant meeting for discussion.

Latest development of the testing and certification industry

10. <u>Dr Helena WONG</u> referred to item no. 10 of the List and opined that the Administration should brief the Panel on the Government's policies in relation to the development of the testing and certification industry, one of the six industries which Hong Kong enjoyed clear advantages, and that the Hong Kong Council for Testing and Certification should be invited to attend the relevant meeting and brief members on its work.

Promoting the industrialization of the beauty industry in Hong Kong

- 11. <u>Dr Helena WONG</u> referred to item no. 14 of the List and opined that the Panel should continue to follow up issues relating to regulation and development of beauty services.
- 12. <u>The Chairman</u> advised that as the two items mentioned by Dr Helena WONG were already on the List, he would discuss with the Administration the proposed timing of discussion of the two items.

Progress on the updating of the copyright regime

13. Mr Charles MOK suggested and Dr Fernando CHEUNG opined that notwithstanding that the legislative exercise to amend the Copyright Ordinance (Cap. 528) ("CO") as introduced by the Copyright (Amendment) Bill 2014 ("the Bill") could not conclude in the legislative session of 2015-2016, the Administration should brief the Panel on the progress in respect of the updating of the copyright regime. Mr MOK and Dr CHEUNG considered that the Administration should continue to deal with issues raised by stakeholders of the industry and the community during the discussion of the Bill, such as the requests for providing copyright exceptions for digital books under CO or by ways of guidelines to address the specific needs of persons with disabilities and dyslexia.

Latest development of Hong Kong Science Park and industrial estates

14. In respect of the policy area of innovation and technology, Mr Charles MOK requested the Administration to brief the Panel on the latest development of Hong Kong Science Park and the relevant Government's policy initiatives, as well as the updated progress on the use of land in industrial estates ("IE") under the revised IE Policy, including the land use policy in relation to the development of data centres.

Progress on the establishment of the Innovation and Technology Venture Fund

15. <u>Mr Charles MOK</u> considered that the Administration should brief the Panel on the implementation details of the \$2 billion Innovation Technology Venture Fund.

Innovation and Technology Fund for Better Living

16. <u>Mrs Regina IP</u> suggested that the Administration should brief the Panel on the operation details of the \$500 million Innovation and Technology Fund for Better Living.

Support measures for small and medium enterprises

- 17. On support measures for small and medium enterprises, Mr CHAN Chun-ying suggested that the subject of enhancing the Small and Medium Enterprises Financing Guarantee Scheme operated by the Hong Kong Mortgage Corporation be discussed by the Panel.
- 18. The Chairman noted members' suggestions and advised that he and Deputy Chairman would meet with the Administration to discuss the work plan of the Panel for the 2016-2017 session. He invited members to notify the Secretariat in writing by Wednesday, 26 October 2016 if they wished to raise other proposed discussion items for the Panel meetings to be held from December 2016 to July 2017.

(*Post-meeting note*: The Secretariat received a letter dated 28 October 2016 from Mr Charles Peter MOK suggesting a number of items for discussion by the Panel. The letter was circulated to members vide LC Paper No. CB(1)59/16-17(01) (Chinese version only) on 2 November 2016.)
