Follow-up actions arising from the meeting on 19 December 2016

Agenda item IV — Actions to combat illegal land filling and fly-tipping of construction and demolition waste

The Administration is requested to:

- (a) list out respectively by the ordinances/regulations set out in Annex I to the Administration's paper (LC Paper No. CB(1)295/16-17(03)) (i) the maximum penalties against illegal land filling and/or fly-tipping of construction and demolition waste, and (ii) the number of prosecutions and convictions made, and the penalties imposed on convicted cases in the past three years from 2013 to mid-2016; and
- (b) review whether it is feasible to enhance the GeoInfo Map that is available for public access at the Lands Department's website by incorporating relevant information, such as baseline environmental conditions and land boundaries, with a view to facilitating monitoring of and enforcement against illegal land filling.
