## Actions to combat illegal land filling and fly-tipping of construction and demolition waste

Thank you for your email of 22 December 2016. We would like to provide supplementary information below in response to Members' questions raised at the meeting of 19 December 2016.

(a) list out respectively by the ordinances/regulations set out in Annex I to the Administration's paper (LC Paper No. CB(1)295/16-17(03)) (i) the maximum penalties against illegal land filling and/or fly-tipping of construction and demolition waste, and (ii) the number of prosecutions and convictions made, and the penalties imposed on convicted cases in the past three years from 2013 to mid-2016; and

Please see the maximum penalties of the ordinances/regulations and the penalties imposed on convicted cases in <u>Annex I</u>.

(b) review whether it is feasible to enhance the GeoInfo Map that is available for public access at the Lands Department's website by incorporating relevant information, such as baseline



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environmental conditions and land boundaries, with a view to facilitating monitoring of and enforcement against illegal land filling.

Please see the reply from Lands Department (LandsD) below:

Approximate locations, boundaries and particulars of individual private lots are publicly accessible information in Hong Kong. At present, if members of the public wish to see the location and approximate boundaries of a private lot and the land status information of its vicinity area, they may purchase a Lot Index Plan (LIP) from the map sales counters of the Survey and Mapping Office of LandsD. Members of the public may also search for the approximate locations and boundaries of individual private lots by its lot number through the GeoInfo Map available on the Internet provided by the Government. Orthophotos which are merged aerial photographs in uniform scale covering all land area of Hong Kong can also be viewed from the GeoInfo Map. As such, LandsD has no plan to create any new database to carry such information which will duplicate the aforementioned sources.
