**2. Tackling marine refuse**

The Administration will brief the Panel on the Administration's work progress on tackling marine refuse and its way forward.

Dr Elizabeth QUAT wrote to the Panel Chairman on 20 October 2016 (LC Paper No. CB(1)30/16-17(01) issued on 20 October 2016) proposing discussion on issues relating to marine littering, and the problem of dumping of plastic waste in particular.

Dr Elizabeth QUAT also proposed discussion on issues relating to the adoption of a sponge city design, and

At the meeting on 28 November 2016, Mr LEUNG Yiu-chung suggested the Panel to discuss the environmental issues relating to illegal disposal of construction and demolition materials into the sea/river. The Administration advised that these issues could be discussed under this item.
