Dear Hon. Tanya Chan,

I am writing to express my opinion to support making laws to ban ivory trade in Hong Kong and I would like to communicate the following points:

1. I SUPPORT the Hong Kong government's ivory ban. The practice of killing elephants in the wild for ivory exhibits the darkest side of humanity for profit. It is absolutely unethical and unacceptable for any developed societies including Hong Kong. Therefore, the government needs to act as it is her legal and ethical obligations.
