Elephants are killed to supply the markets in Asia and Europe.

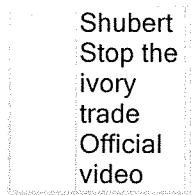
I am Shubert Mwarabu, Elephant conservationists and a musician in Tanzania.
