Review of Outpatient Charges Pegged with the Rates of the Hospital Authority in the Department of Health

Purpose

This paper informs Members of the revised outpatient charges charged by the Department of Health (DH) which are pegged to the rates of the Hospital Authority (HA).

Fee Revision

2. We consulted the Legislative Council Panel on Health Services (the Panel) on 25 April 2017 regarding the revision of fees and charges for public healthcare services in the HA, details of which were set out in the Administration's paper (LC Paper No. CB (2)1224/16-17(01)). Members raised no objection to the revision. The revised HA's fees will take effect from 18 June 2017.

3. It has been the established practice to peg certain DH's fees to HA's rates if they are charged on healthcare services of essentially the same / similar nature. This ensures that the charges for the concerned clinical services are consistent across the public healthcare system. Therefore, subsequent to the earlier briefing for the Panel on the HA's fee revision plan, steps have been taken to bring 17 such outpatient charges for clinical services provided by the DH to the same level of HA's rates. The 17 types of DH's outpatient charges to be revised are at <u>Annex</u>. The revised outpatient charges charged by the DH will take effect from 26 June 2017.
