2. Admission Scheme for Mainland Talents and Professionals ("the Scheme")	4.4.2003 (Joint meeting with the Panel on Security)	The Administration agreed to provide members with progress reports on the Scheme on a regular basis.	Progress report on the Scheme for the period from 1 April 2016 to 30 September 2016 was circulated vide LC Paper No. CB(2)194/16-17 on 15 November 2016.

Occupational safety performance	15.11.2016	The Administration was requested to provide a breakdown of the causes of the 16 natural deaths among the 103 occupational fatalities in the first half of 2016, and advise whether the bereaved family members of the deceased employees concerned had been offered reasonable employees' compensation.
