“Public Transport Strategy Study”

In response to the Members’ request for supplementary information on the captioned subject at the Panel on Transport meeting on 16 June 2017, our reply is set out below.

In paragraph 3.12 of the Report of the Public Transport Strategy Study, it is mentioned that the overall public transport passenger demand is anticipated to increase from 12.6 million daily passenger trips in 2016 to 13.2 million daily passenger trips in 2021. The estimated breakdown is set out below.
