## Select Committee to Inquire into Matters about the Agreement between Mr LEUNG Chun-ying and the Australian firm UGL Limited

I refer to your letter of 1 September 2017 which has been submitted to the Chief Justice of the Court of Final Appeal (the "Chief Justice"). Further to our interim reply of 21 September 2017, I am instructed by the Chief Justice to reply as follows.

2. Your letter requests the provision of a copy of the record(s) of Mr LEUNG Chun-ying's declaration under Article 47 of the Basic Law to the Chief Justice of the Court of Final Appeal and invites the Judiciary Administrator or her representative(s) to attend a hearing of the captioned Select Committee in the future. Independent legal advice has been obtained.

- 3. Your letter states that the Select Committee is formed under Rule 20(6) of the Rules of Procedures of the Legislative Council. Having regard to the relevant circumstances, the Chief Justice does not consider it appropriate to provide the Select Committee with a copy of the record(s) of Mr LEUNG Chunying's declaration under Article 47 of the Basic Law. It is also inappropriate for the Judiciary Administrator or her representative(s) to attend any hearings of the Select Committee.
- 4. If there are any changes in circumstances, the matter may be considered again as appropriate.
