Shipping and Port Control Regulations (Cap. 313A) and

Merchant Shipping (Local Vessels) (General) Regulation (Cap. 548F)

Legislative Amendments for Imposing Conditions on Vessels Navigating in the Vicinity of the Hong Kong-Zhuhai-Macao Bridge

INTRODUCTION

With the completion of the Hong Kong-Zhuhai-Macao Bridge ("HZMB"), we need to take measures to regulate the nearby marine traffic by amending the Shipping and Port Control Regulations (Cap. 313A) ("SAPCR") and the Merchant Shipping (Local Vessels) (General) Regulation (Cap. 548F)¹.

2. At the meeting of the Executive Council on 9 May 2017, the Council ADVISED and the Chief Executive ORDERED that, under section 80 of the Shipping and Port Control Ordinance (Cap. 313), the Shipping and Port Control (Amendment) Regulation 2017, at **Annex A**, should be made to impose restrictions on the height, length and navigational direction of vessels passing through the navigation channels of the two link roads of HZMB.

SAPCR applies to all vessels (except local vessels) in Hong Kong or Hong Kong waters. The Merchant Shipping (Local Vessels) (General) Regulation applies to local vessels.

- 3. To extend the aforementioned restrictions to local vessels, the Secretary for Transport and Housing has made the Merchant Shipping (Local Vessels) (General) (Amendment) Regulation 2017, at **Annex B**, under section 89 of the Merchant Shipping (Local Vessels) Ordinance (Cap. 548).
- 4. The Director of Marine has made the Shipping and Port Control Regulations (Amendment of Fifth Schedule) Notice 2017, at **Annex C**, under section 72(1) of the SAPCR, to reflect the updated boundaries of the Hong Kong International Airport Approach Areas ("HKIAAAs") within which vessels exceeding the stipulated height restrictions are not allowed.

JUSTIFICATIONS

- 5. HZMB links Hong Kong, Zhuhai and Macao. It consists of a Main Bridge in Mainland waters together with boundary crossing facilities and link roads in the three places. There are two link roads in Hong Kong waters, i.e. the Hong Kong Link Road ("HKLR") connecting the Hong Kong Boundary Crossing Facilities ("HKBCF") to the Main Bridge, and the Tuen Mun-Chek Lap Kok Link ("TM-CLKL") linking HKBCF with Northwest New Territories and North Lantau. A map showing the two link roads of HZMB is at **Annex D**.
- 6. Underneath these two link roads, there are a number of navigation channels for vessels to pass through. To ensure navigation safety, restrictions on the dimensions of vessels sailing through are necessary.
- 7. In addition, eight HKIAAAs have been set up to regulate the vessels navigating in the vicinity of the Hong Kong International Airport ("HKIA"). Restrictions on the height of vessels in areas that can pass through range from 15 metres to 30 metres. Due to the construction of the HZMB, part of the waters

near the HKIA has been reclaimed for constructing the HKLR and the HKBCF. The coordinates thus need to be amended to reflect the updated boundaries of the HKIAAAs.

LEGISLATIVE PROPOSALS

- 8. For TM-CLKL, three groups of restricted areas will be established along its Southern Connection. The proposed height limits of the three groups are 21, 12 and 6 metres respectively. Details of the proposed restricted areas are shown at **Annex E**.
- 9. For HKLR, four groups of restricted areas will be established. Having regard to marine traffic and the height of the viaduct, the proposed height limits for the four groups are 41, 12, 10 and 5 metres respectively. Details of the proposed restricted areas of HKLR are shown at **Annex F** (portion in Western waters) and **Annex G** (portion adjacent to the Airport) respectively.
- 10. Within the restricted area with height restriction of 41 metres along HKLR (i.e. the navigation channels underneath the three highest arches), three special areas will be set up to segregate the vessels travelling in opposite directions. Special Area No. 1 will be designated for southbound traffic while Special Area No. 2 for northbound traffic. Special Area No. 3 will be set up between these two areas to separate the two one-way channels. Only small vessels not exceeding 10 metres in length can sail through Special Area No. 3. This arrangement is modelled on the one-way traffic measure adopted for Kap Shui Mun Bridge.

THE REGULATIONS

Shipping and Port Control (Amendment) Regulation 2017

11. The Regulation will amend the SAPCR to impose restrictions on the height, length and navigational direction of vessels passing through the navigation channels of the two link roads.

Merchant Shipping (Local Vessels) (General) (Amendment) Regulation 2017

12. The Regulation will amend the Merchant Shipping (Local Vessels) (General) Regulation (Cap. 548F) to impose restrictions on the height, length and navigational direction of local vessels passing through the navigation channels of the two link roads.

Shipping and Port Control Regulations (Amendment of Fifth Schedule) Notice 2017

13. The Notice will amend the SAPCR to effect changes on the coordinates of the boundaries of HKIAAAs Nos. 2, 3, 5 and 7.

LEGISLATIVE TIMETABLE

14. The regulations and notice will be published in the Gazette on 19 May 2017 and introduced into the Legislative Council on 24 May 2017.

IMPLICATIONS OF THE PROPOSAL

- 15. The proposals are necessary to ensure navigational safety and regulate marine traffic. The establishment of the proposed restricted areas and special areas along the HKLR and the Southern Connection of TM-CLKL with detailed and clear restrictions on vessels sailing through will enhance marine traffic order and prevent collision of tall vessels with the bridge while passing through.
- 16. The proposals have no financial, civil service, economic, productivity, competition, environmental, sustainability, gender or family implications. They are in conformity with the Basic Law, including the provisions concerning human rights. They will not affect the current binding effect of the Shipping and Port Control Ordinance, the Merchant Shipping (Local Vessels) Ordinance and their subsidiary legislation.

PUBLIC CONSULTATION

17. We consulted the Legislative Council Panel on Economic Development on the legislative proposals on 24 April 2017. Members supported the proposed amendments. The Local Vessels Advisory Committee, Port Operations Committee, Pilotage Advisory Committee and High Speed Craft Consultative Committee of the Marine Department, as well as the Traffic and Transport Committee of the Islands District Council were also consulted and they supported the proposal.

PUBLICITY

18. A press release will be issued on 19 May 2017. A spokesman will be available to answer enquires.


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


