

Road Traffic (Amendment) Bill 2018
Debate and voting arrangements

Object of the Bill : To amend the Road Traffic Ordinance (Cap. 374) to empower the Secretary for Transport and Housing to make regulations to provide for the period for which driver identity plates for public service vehicles remain valid; to amend the Road Traffic (Public Service Vehicles) Regulations (Cap. 374 sub. leg. D) to specify the period for which taxi driver identity plates and public light bus driver identity plates remain valid and to revise the requirements relating to the display of the plates; and to provide for related matters.

Voting : To vote on the above clauses standing part of the Bill together

To amend clause 4(5) of the Bill to shorten the proposed validity period for taxi and public light bus driver identity plates from 10 years to five years.
