Council meeting of 11 July 2018

**Two proposed resolutions under
the Interpretation and General Clauses Ordinance**

The President has given permission for Hon James TO to move at the above meeting two proposed resolutions under section 34(2) of the Interpretation and General Clauses Ordinance (Cap. 1) in relation to the Securities and Futures (Professional Investor) (Amendment) Rules 2018 (“the Rules”), published in the Gazette as Legal Notice No. 99 of 2018.

2. Mr TO’s first proposed resolution seeks to repeal the Rules (**Appendix 1**); and his second proposed resolution to amend the Rules (**Appendix 2**). As directed by the President, the two proposed resolutions will be printed in the terms in which they were handed in on the Agenda of the Council.

3. The President has also directed that a **joint debate** on Mr TO’s two proposed resolutions will be held. Afterwards, Mr TO’s first proposed resolution will be put to vote first. If it is **passed**, Mr TO’s second proposed resolution will **not be dealt with**; if it is **negatived**, Mr TO **may** move his second proposed resolution.
