Public Health and Municipal Services Ordinance (Public Pleasure Grounds) (Amendment of Fourth Schedule) Order 2018

(L.N. 1)

L.N. 1 is made by the Director of Leisure and Cultural Services ("the Director") under section 106 of the Public Health and Municipal Services Ordinance (Cap. 132) to:

- (a) set aside 12 places specified in Schedule 1 to L.N. 1 for use as public pleasure grounds with the effect that the general management and control of these new public pleasure grounds is vested in the Director;
- (b) provide that Shing Yip Street Rest Garden specified in Schedule 2 to L.N. 1 ceases to be set aside for use as a public pleasure ground; and
- (c) update the list of public pleasure grounds specified in the Fourth Schedule to Cap. 132 to reflect the above changes.

¹ According to paragraph 5 of the LegCo Brief, Shing Yip Street Rest Garden has to be returned for land sale purpose.

- 2. According to paragraph 8 of the Legislative Council ("LegCo") Brief (with no file reference) issued by the Leisure and Cultural Services Department dated 2 January 2018, the Administration has consulted the District Councils concerned and they supported the amendments.
- 3. As advised by the Clerk to the Panel on Home Affairs, the Panel has not been consulted on L.N. 1.
- 4. L.N. 1 came into operation on the day of publication in the Gazette, i.e. 5 January 2018.

Concluding observations

5. No difficulties have been identified in relation to the legal and drafting aspects of L.N. 1.
