- 4. <u>The Law Society of Hong Kong</u> briefed members on the Trainee Solicitors (Amendment) Rules 2017 (Commencement) Notice ("Commencement Notice"). <u>The Subcommittee</u> deliberated (index of proceedings in **Annex**).
- 5. <u>The Subcommittee</u> completed the scrutiny of the Commencement Notice, and did not propose any amendment to it. <u>Members</u> generally supported the subsidiary legislation.

6. <u>Members</u> agreed that, to allow sufficient time for the Subcommittee to compile a report for consideration by the House Committee, the Chairman would move a motion to extend the scrutiny period of the subsidiary legislation to the Council meeting of 29 November 2017.
