Subcommittee on Toys and Children's Products Safety Ordinance (Amendment of Schedules 1 and 2) Notice 2018

Background brief

Purpose

This paper provides background information on the legislative amendments made under the Toys and Children's Products Safety Ordinance (Amendment of Schedules 1 and 2) Notice 2018 (L.N. 63) ("the Notice"), and summarizes the views and concerns expressed by Members in previous discussion on related matters.

Background

- 2. The Toys and Children's Products Safety Ordinance (Cap. 424) ("the Ordinance") stipulates that a person must not manufacture, import or supply toys and children's products listed in Schedule 2 ("Schedule 2 products") unless they comply with all the applicable requirements contained in any one of the safety standards (international standards or standards adopted by major economies) specified in Schedules 1 and 2 respectively to the Ordinance.
- 3. The specified standards for toys and for three classes of Schedule 2 products, namely "babies' dummies", "children's high chairs and multi-purpose high chairs for domestic use" and "children's paints", have been updated or amended by the standards institutions concerned. The Administration thus intends to apply the updated versions.

The Notice

4. The Notice amends Schedules 1 and 2 to the Ordinance to apply the updates to the standards for toys and for the three classes of Schedule 2 products as mentioned in paragraph 3. Specifically:

Toy Standards -

- (a) the existing part of the International Standard, "IEC 62115 Edition 1.2 (2011-02) [IEC 62115 Edition 1:2003 consolidated with amendment 1:2004 and amendment 2:2010]", has been updated to "IEC 62115:2017 Edition 2.0";
- (b) the existing part of the European Standard "BS EN 71-12:2013" has been updated to "BS EN 71-12:2016"; and
- (c) the existing part of the ASTM Standard "ASTM F963-11" has been updated to "ASTM F963-17".

Schedule 2 Product Standards -

- (a) the existing ASTM Standard "ASTM F963-11" for babies' dummies has been updated to "ASTM F963-17";
- (b) the existing ASTM Standard "ASTM F404-16a" for children's high chairs and multi-purpose high chairs for domestic use has been updated to "ASTM F404-17";
- (c) the existing ASTM Standard "ASTM F963-11" for children's paints has been updated to "ASTM F963-17"; and
- (d) the existing Joint Australian/New Zealand Standard "AS/NZS ISO 8124.3:2012" for children's paints has been updated to "AS/NZS 8124.3:2012 (incorporating Amendment 1:2016)".

A summary of the major changes introduced by the latest standards is in **Appendix I**.

5. The Notice will come into operation on 1 August 2018.

Previous discussion

6. At the meeting of the Subcommittee on Toys and Children's Products Safety Ordinance (Amendment of Schedules 1 and 2) Notice 2017 on 6 June 2017, members discussed issues relating to the updating of certain safety standards for toys and children's products specified in Schedules 1 and 2 to the

Ordinance respectively. A member expressed concern that Hong Kong might become a dumping ground for products that did not meet the latest safety requirements if other countries adopted the new standards ahead of Hong Kong. In response, the Administration advised that actions would be taken to update the relevant safety standards in Hong Kong soon after the new ones were published.

7. Another member was concerned about the low indictment rate for cases of non-compliance with the various safety standards conducted by the Customs and Excise Department ("C&ED"), and how consumers could distinguish toys and children's products in the retail market which did not meet the safety requirements. The Administration advised that C&ED would issue warning notices to traders for minor breaches, whereas prohibition notices would be issued for more serious breaches. It also advised that education and publicity efforts were made by C&ED and the Consumer Council to prevent consumers from buying products that did not meet the prescribed safety standards.

Latest development

- 8. The Panel on Economic Development has not been consulted on the Notice. According to the Administration, it had consulted some 50 major trade associations and organizations advocating children welfare in December 2017, and received two submissions which supported the updating proposal in general.
- 9. At the House Committee meeting on 13 April 2018, Members agreed to form a Subcommittee to study the Notice.
