2. 2018 Voter Registration Campaign	16 October 2017	The Administration was requested to provide the number of elderly electors who had inadvertently lost their eligibility for registration as electors and voting rights due to their failure to respond to the letters from the Registration and Electoral Office by the relevant deadline.	The Administration provided supplementary information on 12 December 2017 [LC Paper No. CB(2) 527/17-18(01)].
3. Briefing on the Chief Executive's 2017 Policy Address	16 October 2017	In response to members' concern about the shortage of places of worship for ethnic minorities, the Administration undertook to provide a breakdown of places of worship in Hong Kong by religion and by district.
