The Administration was requested to provide the following information before submitting the relevant funding proposal to the Public Works Subcommittee:

- (a) (i) the content of the contract for the design and construction of Organic Resources Recovery Centre Phase 2 ("the ORRC2 contract") to be awarded after funding approval by the Finance Committee; (ii) the weightings assigned to different criteria (including technical and price aspects) under the marking scheme for the ORRC2 tender assessment; and (iii) whether the contractor of Organic Resources Recovery Centre Phase 1 ("ORRC1") was allowed to bid the ORRC2 contract and, if so, whether its tender would be given additional scores;
- (b) a breakdown of the estimated design and construction costs of about \$2,500 million of ORRC2;
- (c) a list of food waste treatment facilities using the anaerobic digestion and composting technologies in other major jurisdictions and their respective design and construction costs;
- (d) the possible uses of the compost and renewable energy produced by ORRC1, including whether the compost could be fully absorbed by the local market, and whether and how government departments would give priority to using the compost; and
- (e) the Administration's latest plan for improving the management and recycling of yard waste in Hong Kong.
