Supplementary Information for the Panel on Information Technology and Broadcasting

At the Panel meeting on 12 March 2018, Members requested the Administration to provide information on the expenditure incurred in the development and implementation of electronic certificates (e-Cert) and the number of e-Cert users as well as the data to be collected and disseminated under the pilot "Multi-functional Smart Lampposts" scheme.

(1) <u>e-Cert</u>

As at end-March 2018, the total expenditure incurred in the system development and operation of e-Cert is \$417 million. Since April 2007, the operation of e-Cert services has been outsourced to a private company, which is responsible for the operational cost for providing e-cert service. Since e-Cert was introduced in 2000, the Hongkong Post Certification Authority has issued around 2 044 000 e-Certs of various types. At present, there are

around 119 000 valid e-Certs, of which 12 030 are e-Cert (Personal) including 136 embedded on Smart ID Cards issued by the Immigration Department.

(2) Pilot "Multi-functional Smart Lampposts" Scheme

In consultation with the relevant departments, information on the city data to be collected and disseminated is at **Annex**.
