
Dear Chairman Kwok and Bills Committee Members:

I'm writing to share my view that regulation is the way to go for the new tobacco products.

The proposed ban would be irrational and against the benefit of public health. Smokers should be given a choice to select a better alternative over traditional smoking. This ban will limit smokers to continue consuming the more harmful cigarettes.

With regulations, government authorities are given resources and power to inspect and investigate if all channels in HK comply with the law. Store owners will have less incentive to sell to teens illegally as they do not want to bear the responsibilities when they can do business legally with adult smokers. Therefore, regulating actually makes it harder for teenagers to have access to heated tobacco products.




Dear Chairman Kwok and Bills Committee Members:


I would be grateful if you would allow this letter to be also shared with Members of the Bills Committee.



I would be grateful if you would allow this letter to be also shared with Members of the Bills Committee.
