## Proposed resolutions to amend subsidiary legislation relating to the Central Military Dock Debate and voting arrangements

The following five items of subsidiary legislation relate to the Central Military Dock ("CMD") and the regulation and control of two marine restricted areas at the waters off CMD:

- (a) Protected Places (Amendment) Order 2019;
- (b) Protected Places (Safety) (Authorized Guards) (Amendment) Order 2019;
- (c) Military Installations Closed Areas (Amendment) Order 2019;
- (d) Shipping and Port Control (Amendment) Regulation 2019; and
- (e) Merchant Shipping (Local Vessels) (General) (Amendment) Regulation 2019.

#### Joint debate

Joint debate on the four groups of proposed resolutions (20 in total) moved by Hon AU Nok-hin and Hon CHU Hoi-dick seeking to amend the above five items of subsidiary legislation.

Hon AU Nok-hin's group of proposed resolutions (five in total) seek to repeal the above five items of subsidiary legislation.
