**Immigration Headquarters in Tseung Kwan O
Follow-up Item Raised by Members
at the Meeting on 10 May 2019**

Follow-up Item

According to the LC Paper No. PWSC126/18-19(01), taking into account views of Members of the Public Works Subcommittee, the Government will enhance the design of the building facades of the Immigration Headquarters in Tseung Kwan O, including reducing the area of glass panels and increasing greening area. In this connection, please provide the breakdown in detail (the cost of constructing the glass curtain walls and greening features) to account for keeping the overall project cost at \$6,806.0 million despite the enhanced design of the building facades.

Reply

Taking into account views of Members of the Public Works Subcommittee, the design of the building facades have been enhanced, including adopting cladding panel design in suitable areas, increasing the greening area on the building facades and installing solar shading devices (such as shading fins), so as to reduce the area of glass panels. The enhanced design of the building facades will only slightly increase the cost of the curtain walls. As a whole, it will only bring minimal implication to the overall project cost.
