Thank you for referring the enquiry of Hon AU Nok-hin on 16 January 2019 regarding the above matter. Our reply is as follows:

The feasibility study covers three sites proposed for housing development in Breamar Hill, including a site at Hau Yuen Path, Breamar Hill (the site is at present let under a Short Term Tenancy for use as a school sports ground including a 7-a-side soccer field and two basketball courts with an area of about 6900 square metres), and two vacant sites at Breamar Hill Road and next to St. Joan of Arc Secondary School, Breamar Hill respectively. The existing land use zoning of the three sites is "Government, Institution or Community". The location of the three sites is shown at **Annex**.

The Administration briefed the Eastern District Council about sites in the Eastern District suitable for housing development in February 2015, including the above mentioned three sites. This Department and relevant government departments are conducting a technical feasibility study for converting these three sites for housing development, including housing development parameters, impacts to Breamar Hill Road, Hau Yuen Path and the nearby roads in Breamar Hill, and associated traffic improvement measures and reprovisioning proposal of the school sports ground. After completion of the technical

feasibility study, we will brief the District Council and relevant stakeholders on the outcome of the study.
