## Enquiry from the Hon CHU Hoi－dick

## Information on the Block Allocations of the Capital Works Reserve Fund in 2019－20 <br> Head 701 Subhead 1100CA－Site Formation and Infrastructure Works <br> for Development at Wang Chau，Yuen Long（Road Works）

The Hon CHU Hoi－dick wrote to the Chairman of the Public Works Subcommittee on 15 January 2019，requesting supplementary information on the above project．His enquiry was referred to this Department for follow up and our response is as follows．

1．Please provide the latest information on the rehousing arrangements offered to villagers in the table below．

3. What is the number of appeals lodged with the Lands Tribunal against the amount of ex-gratia compensation for private land?

The Phase 1 Development at Wang Chau involves resumption of 79 private lots in total. As at mid-January 2019, owners of 52 private lots have accepted the ex-gratia compensation offer made by the Government. So far, the Lands Department has not received any claim for statutory compensation or application for appeal to the Lands Tribunal from the land owners.
4. What is the clearance schedule?

The present plan of the Transport and Housing Bureau is to seek funding approval from the Legislative Council in the first quarter of 2019 for the main works of the Phase 1 Development. Subject to funding approval, clearance of structures within the works area of the said project is expected to begin in the second quarter of 2019 so as to facilitate the works department's commencement of the works.
