I. Confirmation of minutes of meeting

Minutes of 8th meeting held on 7 December 2018 (LC Paper No. CB(2)431/18-19)

The minutes were confirmed.

II. Matters arising

- (a) Report by the Chairman on her meeting with the Chief <u>Secretary for Administration</u>
- 2. <u>The Chairman</u> said that there was nothing special to report.

(b) Further report by the Legal Service Division on the proposed resolution under section 4 of the Mutual Legal Assistance in <u>Criminal Matters Ordinance (Cap. 525)</u>

(Paragraphs 13 and 14 of the minutes of the 8th meeting held on 7 December 2018) (LC Paper No. LS32/18-19) (LC Paper No. LS25/18-19)

3. At the invitation of the Chairman, <u>Legal Adviser</u> ("LA") said that the purpose of the proposed resolution was to seek the Legislative Council ("LegCo")'s approval of the Mutual Legal Assistance in Criminal Matters (Mongolia) Order ("the Order") made under section 4 of the Mutual Legal Assistance in Criminal Matters Ordinance (Cap. 525). Members were advised at the last House Committee ("HC") meeting on 7 December 2018 that the Legal Service Division ("LSD") had written to the Administration to request, among others, clarification on certain matters in respect of the Order and would report further if necessary. The Administration's replies were set out in the further report, and LSD had identified no legal or drafting difficulties in relation to the Order.

4. <u>Members</u> did not raise any questions on the proposed resolution and had no objection to the Administration moving the proposed resolution as scheduled at the Council meeting of 9 January 2019.

III. Business arising from previous Council meetings

- (a) Legal Service Division reports on bills referred to the House Committee in accordance with Rule 54(4)
 - (i) Inland Revenue and MPF Schemes Legislation (Tax Deductions for Annuity Premiums and MPF Voluntary Contributions) (Amendment) Bill 2018 (LC Paper No. LS29/18-19)

5. At the invitation of the Chairman, <u>LA</u> briefed Members on the report prepared by LSD on the above Bill.

6. <u>Dr KWOK Ka-ki</u> considered it necessary to form a Bills Committee to study the Bill in detail. <u>Members</u> agreed. Mr WU Chi-wai, Dr KWOK Ka-ki and Mr CHUNG Kwok-pan agreed to join the Bills Committee. (ii) Inland Revenue (Profits Tax Exemption for Funds) (Amendment) Bill 2018 (LC Paper No. LS30/18-19)

7. At the invitation of the Chairman, <u>LA</u> briefed Members on the report prepared by LSD on the above Bill.

8. <u>Mr Kenneth LEUNG</u> considered it necessary to form a Bills Committee to study the Bill in detail. <u>Members</u> agreed. Mr Kenneth LEUNG and Mr CHUNG Kwok-pan agreed to join the proposed Bills Committee.

(iii) Fire Safety (Industrial Buildings) Bill (LC Paper No. LS27/18-19)

9. At the invitation of the Chairman, <u>LA</u> briefed Members on the report prepared by LSD on the above Bill.

10. <u>Mr SHIU Ka-fai</u> considered it necessary to form a Bills Committee to study the Bill in detail. <u>Members</u> agreed. The following Members agreed to join the Bills Committee: Mr WU Chi-wai, Mr SHIU Ka-fai, Mr Jeremy TAM and Mr Tony TSE.

(iv) Discrimination Legislation (Miscellaneous Amendments) Bill 2018 (LC Paper No. LS28/18-19)

11. At the invitation of the Chairman, \underline{LA} briefed Members on the report prepared by LSD on the above Bill.

12. <u>Mrs Regina IP, Mr CHAN Chi-chuen, Ms Alice MAK, Dr Helena</u> <u>WONG</u> and <u>Mr HUI Chi-fung</u> considered it necessary to form a Bills Committee to study the Bill in detail. <u>Members</u> agreed. The following Members agreed to join the Bills Committee: Mrs Regina IP, Mr CHAN Chi-chuen, Ms Alice MAK, Dr Helena WONG, Mr HUI Chi-fung and Dr CHENG Chung-tai.

(b) Legal Service Division report on subsidiary legislation gazetted on 7 December 2018 and tabled in Council on 12 December 2018

(LC Paper No. LS31/18-19)

13. At the invitation of the Chairman, <u>LA</u> briefed Members on the report prepared by LSD on 22 items of subsidiary legislation (i.e. L.N. 241 to L.N. 262) which were gazetted on 7 December 2018 and tabled in Council on 12 December 2018. <u>LA</u> said that LSD was scrutinizing the legal and drafting aspects of L.N. 246 to L.N. 258 and would report further if necessary.

14. <u>Dr KWOK Ka-ki</u> considered it necessary to form a subcommittee to study the Private Healthcare Facilities Ordinance (Specification of Date for Section 135(1)(a)) Notice (L.N. 261) and the Private Healthcare Facilities Ordinance (Specification of Date for Section 136(1)(a)) Notice (L.N. 262) in detail. <u>Members</u> agreed. Dr KWOK Ka-ki agreed to join the proposed subcommittee.

15. <u>Members</u> did not raise any questions on the other 20 items of subsidiary legislation (i.e. L.N. 241 to L.N. 260).

16. <u>The Chairman</u> reminded Members that the deadline for amending the above 22 items of subsidiary legislation would be the Council meeting of 9 January 2019, or that of 30 January 2019 if extended by a resolution of the Council.

IV. Reports of Bills Committees and subcommittees

(a) Report of the Subcommittee on Land (Miscellaneous <u>Provisions) (Amendment) Regulation 2018</u> (LC Paper No. CB(1)289/18-19)

17. <u>Mr Abraham SHEK</u>, Chairman of the Subcommittee, briefed Members on the deliberations of the Subcommittee as detailed in its report. <u>Mr SHEK</u> said that the Subcommittee generally supported the Amendment Regulation and that neither the Subcommittee nor the Administration would propose any amendments to it. (b) Report of the Subcommittee on Foreign Lawyers Practice (Amendment) Rules 2018 (Commencement) Notice, Solicitors' Practice (Amendment) Rules 2018 (Commencement) Notice and Summary Disposal of Complaints (Solicitors) (Amendment) Rules 2018 (Commencement) Notice (LC Paper No. CB(4)314/18-19)

18. <u>Mr Paul TSE</u>, on behalf of the Chairman of the Subcommittee, Mr Dennis KWOK, who was unable to attend the meeting, briefed Members on the deliberations of the Subcommittee as detailed in its report. <u>Mr TSE</u> said that the Subcommittee had no objection to the three items of subsidiary legislation and would not propose any amendments to them.

19. <u>Mr TSE</u> further said that the Subcommittee had written to The Law Society of Hong Kong ("the Law Society") requesting it to provide a written response to the enquiries raised by members of the Subcommittee about issues relating to the enforcement of the Foreign Lawyers Practice Rules (Cap. 159R) and review of the foreign lawyers' regulatory regime, so as to facilitate their discussion of relevant issues in other forums of LegCo in the future. <u>Members</u> noted that the Law Society's response had yet to be received at the time when the Subcommittee submitted its report to HC.

(c) Report of the Subcommittee on Antiquities and Monuments (Declaration of Monuments and Historical Buildings) (Consolidation) (Amendment) Notice 2018

(LC Paper No. CB(1)315/18-19)

20. <u>Dr KWOK Ka-ki</u>, Chairman of the Subcommittee, briefed Members on the deliberations of the Subcommittee as detailed in its report. <u>Dr KWOK</u> said that the Subcommittee had no objection to the Amendment Notice and that both the Subcommittee and the Administration would not propose any amendments to it.

21. <u>The Chairman</u> reminded Members that the period for amending the five items of subsidiary legislation studied by the above three Subcommittees would expire at the Council meeting of 9 January 2019, and the deadline for giving notice of amendments, if any, would be Wednesday, 2 January 2019.

V. Position on Bills Committees and subcommittees

(LC Paper No. CB(2)432/18-19)

22. <u>The Chairman</u> said that as at 13 December 2018, there were eight Bills Committees, 10 subcommittees under HC and six subcommittees on policy issues under Panels in action. Eight subcommittees on policy issues were on the waiting list.
