Report No. 11/18-19 of the House Committee on Consideration of Subsidiary Legislation and Other Instruments

Purpose

This report gives the outcome of the consideration of the House Committee on subsidiary legislation the period for amendment of which will expire at the Council meeting of 20 February 2019.

Subsidiary legislation considered

2. The House Committee has considered the following items of subsidiary legislation:

- 3. A subcommittee was proposed to be formed to study item (1) in detail at the House Committee meeting on 25 January 2019. Since only two Members have signified to join the proposed subcommittee by the deadline for signification of membership, it cannot be formed by virtue of House Rules 21(b) and 26(f).
- 4. In respect of item (2), the House Committee considered it not necessary to form a subcommittee to study this item of subsidiary legislation.

Note: The House Committee formed a subcommittee to study the following two items of subsidiary legislation at its meeting on 15 February 2019. Hon Starry LEE, Chairman of the House Committee, has given notice to move a proposed resolution at the Council meeting of 20 February 2019 to extend the period for amending these two items of subsidiary legislation to the Council meeting of 20 March 2019.
