# I. Election of Chairman and Deputy Chairman

#### Election of Chairman

Mr James TO, member who had the highest precedence in Council among members of the Subcommittee present, presided over the election of the Chairman. Mr TO called for nominations for the chairmanship of

the Subcommittee. Mr WONG Ting-kwong was nominated by Mr Christopher CHEUNG and the nomination was seconded by Mr CHAN Hak-kan. Mr WONG Ting-kwong accepted the nomination. Mr TO called for other nominations.

- 2. Mr Dennis KWOK was nominated by Ms Tanya CHAN and the nomination was seconded by Mr Alvin YEUNG. Mr Dennis KWOK accepted the nomination.
- 3. As there was no other nomination, <u>Mr James TO</u> then proceeded to the election and announced that voting be conducted by secret ballot. After all the members present had cast their votes, <u>Mr TO</u> invited Mr Christopher CHEUNG and Ms Tanya CHAN, who had nominated the two candidates respectively, to monitor the counting of votes.
- 4. After the votes were counted, <u>Mr James TO</u> announced that 29 members voted for Mr WONG Ting-kwong and 15 members voted for Mr Dennis KWOK respectively. <u>Mr TO</u> declared Mr WONG Ting-kwong elected as the Chairman of the Subcommittee. <u>Mr WONG Ting-kwong</u> then took the chair.

### Election of Deputy Chairman

- 5. <u>The Chairman</u> called for nominations for the deputy chairmanship of the Subcommittee. Mr Dennis KWOK was nominated by <u>Mr Kenneth LEUNG</u> and the nomination was seconded by <u>Ms Claudia MO</u>. <u>Mr Dennis KWOK</u> accepted the nomination. <u>The Chairman</u> called for other nominations.
- 6. Ms YUNG Hoi-yan was nominated by Ms Elizabeth QUAT and the nomination was seconded by Mr Steven HO. Ms YUNG Hoi-yan accepted the nomination.
- 7. As there was no other nomination, <u>the Chairman</u> announced a vote by secret ballot. After all members had cast their votes, <u>the Chairman</u> invited Mr Kenneth LEUNG and Ms Elizabeth QUAT, who had nominated the two candidates to monitor the counting of votes.
- 8. After the votes were counted, <u>the Chairman</u> announced that 19 and 29 members voted for Mr Dennis KWOK and Ms YUNG Hoi-yan respectively. <u>The Chairman</u> declared Ms YUNG Hoi-yan elected as the Deputy Chairman of the Subcommittee.

#### **II.** Meeting with the Administration

- 9. <u>The Subcommittee</u> deliberated (index of proceedings attached at **Annex**).
- 10. <u>The Subcommittee</u> requested the Administration to provide the following information:
  - (a) the criteria of invoking and the scope of application of the Emergency Regulations Ordinance (Cap. 241) ("ERO");
  - (b) the relationship between ERO and the Prohibition on Face Covering Regulation ("the Regulation"), as well as the factors to be taken into consideration in deciding whether to repeal the Regulation; and
  - (c) the penalty under similar laws imposing prohibition on face covering in other western democratic jurisdictions as mentioned in the Legislative Council ("LegCo") Brief, as well as their mechanism to monitor the work of the Police and the powers of their monitoring bodies in handling and investigating complaints against the Police.
- 11. <u>ALA3</u> was requested to provide his advice in writing regarding the implications of the impending judicial review proceedings on the scrutiny of the Regulation by the Subcommittee / LegCo.

(*Post-meeting note*: ALA3's advice was issued vide LC Paper No. LS13/19-20 on 25 October 2019.)

12. The Chairman said that Mr Dennis KWOK and Mr Alvin YEUNG had indicated their respective intention to move motions at the meeting. The Chairman pointed out that Mr Dennis KWOK's proposed motion was related to the extension of the scrutiny period of the Regulation and that some members had made a similar suggestion at the meeting. He proposed to deal with the matter in one go. Members agreed. Members further agreed that to allow more time for the Subcommittee to examine the Regulation, the Chairman would on behalf of the Subcommittee move a motion to extend the scrutiny period of the Regulation to the Council meeting of 4 December 2019.

- 13. Owing to time constraint, <u>the Chairman</u> said that Mr Alvin YEUNG's proposed motion on repealing the Regulation would be dealt with at the next meeting.
- 14. <u>The Subcommittee</u> also agreed in principle to invite the public to give views on the Regulation. Relevant meeting arrangements would be discussed at the next meeting.

# III. Any other business

- 15. <u>The Subcommittee</u> agreed that the next meeting would be held on 28 October 2019 at 2:30 pm.
- 16. There being no other business, the meeting ended at 10:45 am.
