I. Meeting with the Administration

<u>The Subcommittee</u> deliberated (index of proceedings attached at **Annex**).

- 2. At the invitation of members, <u>Assistant Legal Adviser 3</u> made the following points regarding the judgment on the applications for judicial review ("JR") respectively made by 24 Members and Mr LEUNG Kwok-hung in relation to the Prohibition on Face Covering Regulation ("the Regulation") (HCAL 2945/2019 and 2949/2019):
 - (a) the court had held that the Emergency Regulations Ordinance (Cap. 241), insofar as it empowered the Chief Executive in Council to make regulations on any occasion of public danger, was incompatible with the Basic Law;

- (b) the court had also held that the restrictions that section 3(1)(b), (c) and (d) and section 5 of the Regulation imposed on fundamental rights went further than was reasonably necessary for the furtherance of the legitimate objects and therefore did not pass the proportionality test;
- (c) the court, however, had made it clear that it was not the court's judgment that "anti-mask" law was generally objectionable or unconstitutional. Its validity must depend on the details of the legislation and the particular societal aims sought to be pursued by the measure being brought in through the legislation;
- (d) there would be a further hearing for the parties to make submissions on the appropriate relief and costs;
- (e) the scrutiny period of the Regulation had already expired;
- (f) the Subcommittee was formed under the House Committee ("HC") to study the Regulation. The Subcommittee needed to submit a report to HC concerning the Subcommittee's deliberations:
- (g) it was noted that some members were concerned about the actions that would be taken by the Administration in response to the judgment; and
- (h) it would be for the Subcommittee to decide whether it would invite the Administration to give a response regarding the judgment of the JR concerned and further actions that would be taken by the Administration.
- 3. <u>The Subcommittee</u> agreed to invite the Administration to give a response to the judgment. At the invitation of the Chairman, <u>the Administration</u> said that it would take some time to study the judgment and seek relevant legal advice to decide its next course of action. It further explained that, generally speaking, the Administration would suspend law enforcement actions in respect of a piece of legislation that had been ruled by the courts to be unconstitutional.

II. Any other business

- 4. <u>The Subcommittee</u> considered that its scrutiny work should come to a halt having regard to the latest development and the fact that the scrutiny period of the Regulation had already expired. In the light of the above, the Subcommittee had not examined the provisions of the Regulation section-by-section or considered the draft amendments proposed by individual Members to the Regulation.
- 5. There being no other business, the meeting ended at 3:05 pm.
