

Subcommittee on Prohibition on Face Covering Regulation

**List of follow-up actions arising from the discussion
at the meeting on 12 November 2019**

The Subcommittee requested the Administration to provide the following information:

- (a) the adverse impacts which could be brought about by the Prohibition on Face Covering Regulation ("the Regulation") as mentioned by the Chief Executive before the Regulation coming into operation, e.g. individuals' rights and the economy;
- (b) the details of the consultation with the Food and Health Bureau regarding the impacts on public hygiene relating to the defence of reasonable excuse on the ground of "a pre-existing medical or health reason" under section 4(3)(c) of the Regulation; and
- (c) the top five cities ranked with the highest police-to-public ratio worldwide.
