**Joint letter from 24 Members**

Thanks for your letter of 4 January 2019.

In the report on China adopted by the Working Group on the Universal Periodic Review (UPR) of the United Nations Human Rights Council (UNHRC) on 9 November 2018, there are six recommendations on the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (HKSAR). Two are for China covering HKSAR (one covers Macao SAR as well), and the remaining four are for HKSAR only.

The HKSAR Government is examining these recommendations with a view to forming a position on them, bearing in mind that the recommendations are put up for our consideration for acceptance and that representatives of the civil society have already made known their view that we should take all the recommendations on board. HKSAR's position will be stated at the plenary meeting of the UNHRC scheduled for March 2019, and we will report the UPR examination process to the Panel on Constitutional Affairs at its meeting scheduled for April 2019.
