Election of Chairman

Mr WU Chi-wai, the incumbent Chairman of the Panel on Commerce and Industry ("the Panel"), presided over the election of the Chairman of the Panel for the 2018-2019 session. He invited nominations for the chairmanship.

- 2. Mr WONG Ting-kwong was nominated by Mr Christopher CHEUNG. Members noted the nomination requirement for the chairmanship of the Panel as provided for under Rule 77(6) of the Rules of Procedure that a Member who was the chairman or deputy chairman of a Government advisory body in respect of matters which a Panel considered to be directly related to the terms of reference of the Panel should not be the chairman or deputy chairman of the Panel. Members noted Mr WONG's present chairmanship of the Business Facilitation Advisory Committee, which was one of the Government advisory bodies relevant to the Panel, and agreed not to deal with Mr WONG's nomination for the chairmanship.
- 3. Mr YIU Si-wing was then nominated by Mr WONG Ting-kwong and the nomination was seconded by Ms Alice MAK. Mr YIU accepted the nomination.
- 4. There being no other nominations, Mr YIU Si-wing was declared Chairman of the Panel for the 2018-2019 session.

Election of Deputy Chairman

5. <u>The Chairman</u> invited nominations for the deputy chairmanship for the 2018-2019 session. Mr Alvin YEUNG was nominated by Mr WU Chi-wai and the nomination was seconded by Mr Charles Peter MOK. Mr YEUNG accepted the nomination.

6. There being no other nominations, Mr Alvin YEUNG was declared Deputy Chairman of the Panel for the 2018-2019 session.

- 7. <u>Members</u> noted the proposed schedule of regular meetings of the Panel for the 2018-2019 session, which was tabled at the meeting.

Mr SHIU Ka-fai noted that the Administration proposed to hold a joint meeting of the Panel, Panel on Economic Development ("EDEV Panel") and Panel on Information Technology and Broadcasting ("ITB Panel") to discuss the proposed framework for implementing a cooling-off period and legislative proposals for the establishment of a statutory Do-not-call Register for strengthening regulation of person-to-person telemarketing calls (item no. 6 of the List). He suggested that separate discussions should be arranged for the subjects of "the proposed framework for implementing a cooling-off period" and "the legislative proposals for the establishment of a statutory Do-not-call Register for strengthening regulation of person-to-person telemarketing calls", so as to allow more focused discussion and sufficient time for members' deliberations on the The Chairman said that the Clerk would follow up the matter with the Administration.

13. Mr Steven HO enquired if the Panel could arrange to discuss with the Administration the enforcement situation of the Trade Descriptions Ordinance (Cap. 362) and the need for a review of the relevant enforcement authority, which he considered might be of relevance to the purview of the The Chairman said that the Clerk would follow up Mr HO's Panel. enquiry.
