### I. Election of Chairman and Deputy Chairman

Election of Chairman for the 2018-2019 session

Mr Jeffrey LAM, incumbent Chairman of the Panel, presided over the election of Chairman for the 2018-2019 session.

- 2. <u>Mr Jeffrey LAM</u> invited nominations for the chairmanship. <u>Ms Alice MAK</u> nominated Mr CHUNG Kwok-pan and the nomination was seconded by <u>Mr Charles MOK</u>. <u>Mr CHUNG</u> accepted the nomination.
- 3. <u>Mr Jeffrey LAM</u> called for other nominations. There being no other nomination, <u>Mr LAM</u> declared Mr CHUNG Kwok-pan elected as the Chairman of the Panel for the 2018-2019 session. <u>Mr CHUNG</u> then took the chair.

## Election of Deputy Chairman for the 2018-2019 session

4. <u>The Chairman</u> invited nominations for the deputy chairmanship. <u>Mr Alvin YEUNG</u> nominated Mr WU Chi-wai and the nomination was seconded by <u>Mr Andrew WAN</u>. <u>Mr WU</u> accepted the nomination. There being no other nomination, <u>the Chairman</u> declared Mr WU elected as the Deputy Chairman of the Panel for the 2018-2019 session.

5. <u>Members</u> noted the proposed schedule of regular monthly meetings of the Panel for the 2018-2019 session tabled at the meeting.
