Follow-up to special meeting on 1 March 2019

I refer to your letter dated 4 March 2019, requesting the Administration to provide a written response to the follow-up items arising from the discussion at the above meeting on "Statutory cooling-off period for beauty and fitness services consumer contracts". Our response is set out below.
