

I would like to raise my objection to the proposed building directly to the east of the Tung Chung MTR because:

1. We already have a wet market in Fu Tung. It is good and has just been refurbished. We like it and don't believe we need another one next door.
2. Tung Chung residents have had enough disruption, dust and noise pollution.
3. We want less pollution and rubbish - not more.
4. We want leisure facilities for our children to play, spaces for our community to enjoy, not more money making schemes. Spend the money on that instead.
5. There needs to be some open space - we don't want another Mongkok.
6. We don't really know what your plans are - information is almost zero and hidden away in a labyrinthine bureaucracy. So we don't trust you I am afraid.
7. If it is a wet market, why is it 30 floors high? If the Government builds housing on top, it should be of civilised size - Government flats here are criminally small.
8. We want shops for locals - not unaffordable tourist traps.
9. We want buses to and from South Lantau that you can actually get on - quiet, clean ones.
10. We don't believe that the Government plans are for the benefit of residents; merely the enrichment of property, retail and construction tycoons.

I hope that you will consider my view and that you will consult more widely and openly with the people of Tung Chung before making your decision.
