Dear Dr Siu,

Thank you for your email dated 7 January 2019.

Referring to our response dated 15 November to you, the JC School of Public Health and Primary Care has been appointed by the Government as the Accreditation Agent in the Accredited Registers Scheme (AR Scheme). The accreditation assessment is based on a set of six standards namely governance, operational effectiveness, risk management and quality improvement, standards for registrants, educational and training requirements, and management of the register. One additional assessment criteria is that the applying organisation should be able to demonstrate inclusiveness through the use of reasonable criteria to admit professionals with different educational background and training from local and overseas institutions. The Survey Team will evaluate the standards and the supporting evidence submitted by the applying organisation to assess whether it meets the accreditation criteria. An Accreditation Panel will study the Survey Report and discuss the accreditation result at a meeting, and submit its recommendation to the Department of Health.

The Standards are set by the profession among discussion under the principle of self-regulation. The Division of Clinical Psychology of The Hong Kong Psychological Society (DCP) has been selected to proceed to the Accreditation Assessment first. The Accreditation Assessment is in process.
