## Information note prepared by the Legislative Council Secretariat for the meeting on 20 May 2019

#### Registration of non-locally trained medical practitioners

Any person wishing to practise medicine, surgery or midwifery in Hong Kong is required to apply for registration with the Medical Council of Hong Kong ("the Medical Council") in accordance with the Medical Registration Ordinance (Cap. 161) ("the Ordinance"). There are two main types of registration under the General Register, namely, full registration (Part I of the General Register) and limited registration (Part III of the General Register).

- 2. According to sections 8(1)(a) and 9 of the Ordinance, persons who (a) have been awarded a degree of medicine and surgery by the University of Hong Kong ("HKU") or The Chinese University of Hong Kong ("CUHK"); and (b) have been granted a certificate of experience of employment in a resident medical capacity in an approved hospital or institution for a prescribed period are qualified to be registered as medical practitioners.
- 3. For non-locally trained medical graduates, those who (a) have passed the Licensing Examination administered by the Medical Council; and (b) completed a prescribed period of assessment in an approved hospital or institution<sup>2</sup> as determined by the Medical Council under section 10A of the Ordinance are qualified to be registered as medical practitioners. The Licensing Examination comprises three parts, namely, Part I Examination in Professional Knowledge,<sup>3</sup>

According to the Medical Council, the period should be not less than 12 months.

According to the Medical Council, the period of assessment is normally 12 months.

Part I consists of two papers, each of which comprises 120 multiple-choice questions. It is designed to test candidates' professional knowledge in Basic Sciences, Medical Ethics/Community Medicine, Medicine, Surgery, Orthopaedic Surgery, Psychiatry, Paediatrics and Obstetrics & Gynaecology. Questions are in both English and Chinese. Candidates with a total mark of 50% (i.e. 120 marks) or above for two papers are considered to have passed, provided that the mark received for each paper is 40% (i.e. 48 marks) or above.

Part II - Proficiency Test in Medical English,<sup>4</sup> and Part III - Clinical Examination.<sup>5</sup> Candidate have to pass Part I and Part II Examinations before applying to sit for Part III Examination.<sup>6</sup> As regards the assessment, the interns will receive clinical instructions to familiarize themselves with the local medical system and commonly found diseases. To facilitate more non-locally trained medical graduates to practise in Hong Kong, the Medical Council has increased the frequency of the Licensing Examination from once to twice a year starting from 2014 and launched a Virtual Education Resource Centre in October 2018. The number of candidates who sat and passed the Licensing Examination for the period between 1996 and 2018 is set out in **Appendix I**. A breakdown of the above numbers by the jurisdictions of qualification held by the candidates for the period between 2014 and 2018 is set out in **Appendix II**. Separately, more flexibility has been introduced by the Medical Council for the internship arrangement since 2016.<sup>7</sup> The number of Licentiate Interns recruited by the Hospital Authority ("HA") as Resident Trainees in the Annual Recruitment Exercise for Resident Trainee was 29 in 2014-2015, 62 in 2015-2016, 31 in 2016-2017, 29 in 2017-2018 and 35 in 2018-2019.

4. Section 14A of the Ordinance provides that the Medical Council may determine and promulgate from time to time the employment or type of employment in respect of which limited registration is appropriate or necessary.<sup>8</sup>

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>4</sup> Part II is a written English paper consists of 4 questions (each of which carries a maximum of 10 marks) designed to test whether candidates' command of English is adequate for professional purposes. Questions are in English. The passing mark is 20.

Part III is designed to test candidates' ability to apply professional knowledge to clinical problems in Medicine, Surgery (including cases of Orthopaedic Surgery), Obstetrics & Gynaecology and Paediatrics. Candidates can answer Part III in English, Cantonese or Putonghua (choice to be made in application form).

A candidate meeting the respective requirements specified by the Medical Council can apply for exemption from taking Parts I or III of the Licensing Examination. The requirements are set out in Guidelines 2 issued by the Licentiate Committee of the Medical Council (English version only) which can be assessed at the Medical Council website (<a href="https://leip.mchk.org.hk/mchkdocs/guidelines2">https://leip.mchk.org.hk/mchkdocs/guidelines2</a> exemption.pdf).

Any person who has passed the Licensing Examination and meeting the respective requirements specified by the Medical Council may apply for exemption from a specialty of internship assessment; deferment of internship training; and reduction of the period of assessment for a specialty of internship training. The requirements are set out in Guidelines 3 issued by the Licentiate Committee of the Medical Council (English version only) which can be assessed at the Medical Council website (<a href="https://leip.mchk.org.hk/mchkdocs/guidelines3">https://leip.mchk.org.hk/mchkdocs/guidelines3</a> internship revised.pdf).

A total of 12 promulgations have so far been published by the Medical Council in the Gazette. The types of employment described in promulgation nos. 1, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 11 no longer exist. Application for limited registration can currently be made under the types of employment set out in promulgation nos. 2, 3, 4, 9, 10 and 12. These six promulgations are available at the Medical Council website (<a href="http://www.mchk.org.hk/english/registration/limited">http://www.mchk.org.hk/english/registration/limited</a> registration.html).

Subject to Section 14(2A) of the Ordinance, a person may be registered as a medical practitioner with limited registration if the Medical Council is satisfied that the person has been selected for an employment or for a type of employment determined and promulgated by the Medical Council; has obtained an acceptable overseas qualifications; has had adequate and relevant full-time post-qualification clinical experience; is registered with an approved medical authority outside Hong Kong; and is of good character. Since April 2018, the term of registration and the term for which such a medical practitioner could renew his or her registration is a period of not exceeding three years. A summary of the number of medical practitioners with limited registration under the promulgations currently in force during the period between 2014 and 2018 is in **Appendix III**.

5. There are wide public concerns over the medical manpower constraint in HA in recent years. Under promulgation no. 2 which was published by the Medical Council in the Gazette on 23 December 1994, one of the types of full-time employment in respect of which limited registration is appropriate and necessary is employment as a medical practitioner by HA for the purpose of research work or for such clinical practice of medicine or hospital work, as specified by HA.<sup>9</sup> HA has resorted to recruit non-locally trained medical practitioners under limited registration as one of its measures to alleviate the heavy workload of frontline medical practitioners since 2011-2012. 2019, HA has expanded the scope of limited registration recruitment to all specialties at the rank of Service Resident, and to recruit non-locally trained specialists at the rank of Associate Consultant in eight specialties which face significant shortage of specialists (i.e. Anaesthesia, Anatomical Pathology, Cardiothoracic Surgery, Otorhinolaryngology, Obstetrics and Gynaecology, Ophthalmology, Radiology and Nuclear Medicine). 10 According to the list of

Under promulgation no. 2, the other two types of full-time employment in respect of which limited registration is appropriate and necessary are employment as a medical practitioner by (a) the Government for the purpose of research work or for such clinical practice of medicine or special health care services, as specified by the Director of Health; and (c) by HKU or CUHK for the purpose of teaching, research or performing hospital work, in the Faculty of Medicine. According to the list of registered medical practitioners on the Medical Council website, there were one, 31 and 55 non-locally trained medical practitioners employed by the Department of Health, HKU and CUHK under limited registration as at 14 May 2019.

The recruitment requirements in respect of Resident include: (a) possess qualification comparable to the Intermediate Examinations of constituent Colleges of the Hong Kong Academy of Medicine; (b) three years of clinical experience as post-internship registered medical practitioner; (c) proficient in English; and (d) proficient in Cantonese (except for Anaesthesia, Pathology and Radiology). The recruitment requirements in respect of Associate Consultant include: (a) possess full registration with an approved medical authority outside Hong Kong; (b) certified or registered as a specialist or equivalent in relevant specialty in the country of practicing medicine, with the certification or registration system of the specialist status being a nationally or officially recognized system; (c) proficient in English; and (d) proficient in Cantonese (except for Anaesthesia, Pathology and Radiology).

registered medical practitioners on the Medical Council website, there were 14 non-locally trained medical practitioners working in HA under limited registration as at 14 May 2019.

6. At its Policy Meetings held on 3 April and 8 May 2019, the Medical Council considered various proposals on relaxation of internship assessment for non-locally trained medical practitioners with specialist status. It was approved at the meeting on 8 May 2019 that non-locally trained medical practitioners with specialist status who passed the Licensing Examination would be exempted from the internship assessment if they had served in HA, the Department of Health, HKU and CUHK for three years.
