#### Action

# I. Election of Chairman (and Deputy Chairman) and application for late membership

#### Election of Chairman

<u>Mr Abraham SHEK</u>, the member who had the highest precedence among those who were present at the meeting, presided over the election of the Chairman of the Joint Subcommittee. <u>Mr SHEK</u> invited nominations for the chairmanship of the Joint Subcommittee. Mr LAU Kwok-fan was nominated by <u>Mr KWOK Wai-keung</u> and the nomination was seconded by <u>Ir Dr LO Wai-kwok</u>. <u>Mr LAU</u> accepted the nomination.

2. As there was no other nomination, <u>Mr Abraham SHEK</u> declared Mr LAU Kwok-fan elected as the Chairman of the Joint Subcommittee. Mr LAU then took the chair.

#### Election of Deputy Chairman

3. <u>The Chairman</u> called for nominations for the deputy chairmanship of the Joint Subcommittee. Mr KWOK Wai-keung was nominated by <u>Mr Vincent CHENG</u> and the nomination was seconded by <u>Mr Abraham SHEK</u>. <u>Mr KWOK</u> accepted the nomination.

4. As there was no other nomination, <u>the Chairman</u> declared Mr KWOK Wai-keung elected as the Deputy Chairman of the Joint Subcommittee.

# Application for late membership

5. <u>The Chairman</u> said that Dr Junius HO had submitted a late application for joining the Joint Subcommittee (LC Paper No. CB(2)1073/18-19(01)), which was tabled at the meeting. <u>Members</u> agreed to accept the application.

# II. Meeting arrangements and items for discussion

6. <u>The Joint Subcommittee</u> deliberated (index of proceedings attached at **Annex**).

Members noted a letter from Mr SHIU Ka-chun proposing items for 7. Subcommittee discussion the Joint (LC Paper by No. CB(2)1074/18-19(01)) and a list of related issues deliberated by Panel on Development and Panel on Home Affairs (LC Paper No. CB(2)1074/18-19(02)), which were tabled at the meeting.

8. At the invitation of the Chairman, <u>members</u> had given their views on items for discussion at future meetings. <u>The Chairman</u> said that he and the Deputy Chairman would meet with the Administration to discuss the work plan of the Joint Subcommittee, and work out the meeting arrangements as appropriate. <u>Members</u> noted that they would be informed of the date for holding the next meeting in due course.
