**Follow-up Action Arising from Meeting on 17 May 2019
Regarding “Latest Situation on Increasing
the Provision of Car Parking Spaces”**

At the captioned meeting, Panel Members enquired about the action taken by the Transport Department (“TD”) in relation to the abandoned motorcycles at on-street motorcycle parking spaces and the number of abandoned motorcycles removed in the past three years. Out reply is set out below.

To assess the utilisation of on-street parking spaces for motorcycles, TD engaged a consultant to conduct a territory-wide survey on the subject in 2017. The survey mainly collected data on the utilisation rates of on-street motorcycle parking spaces, whether vehicle licence discs were displayed on parked motorcycles and, if so, whether they were valid. With the results of the survey, TD has referred to the Hong Kong Police Force and the Lands Department cases of failure to display vehicle licence discs or invalid vehicle licence discs being displayed on motorcycles for follow-up actions in

accordance with the applicable legislation. In 2016, 2017 and 2018, relevant law enforcement departments removed from on-street motorcycle parking spaces 20, 34 and 1 suspected abandoned motorcycles respectively.

TD will continue to keep in view the subject matter.
