Commencement of the amendments to the Merchant Shipping (Seafarers) Ordinance (Cap. 478) and its subsidiary legislation for the entry into force of the 2006 Maritime Labour Convention in Hong Kong

INTRODUCTION

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The 2006 Maritime Labour Convention ("MLC") will be extended to Hong Kong on 20 December 2018. To bring into operation the provisions in the Merchant Shipping (Seafarers) Ordinance (Cap. 478) ("the Ordinance") and its subsidiary legislation that implement the requirements of the MLC, as well as a provision in the Schedule to the Administrative Appeals Board Ordinance (Cap. 442) which relates to the MLC, the Secretary for Transport and Housing ("STH") has made the following 15 commencement notices —

BACKGROUND

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regulations under the Ordinance –

3. Promulgated by the International Labour Organization ("ILO"), the MLC sets out a comprehensive set of global standards for the working and living conditions of seafarers and seeks to protect the welfare of seafarers. The MLC entered into force globally on 20 August 2013. To prepare for the extension of the MLC to Hong Kong¹, the Merchant Shipping (Seafarers) (Amendment) Ordinance 2013 ("the 2013 Ordinance") was enacted in 2013 to align the provisions under the Ordinance with the requirements in the MLC.

As Hong Kong is not a member of the ILO, the MLC will only take effect in Hong Kong if China extends its application to Hong Kong. The Central People's Government's assistance has been sought in extending the MLC to Hong Kong. ILO has recently notified us that the MLC would come into force in Hong Kong on 20 December 2018.

- 4. In 2016, one new regulation, 11 amendment regulations and two repeal regulations (collectively referred to as "2016 Regulations") were introduced into the LegCo to incorporate the detailed requirements of the MLC into the subsidiary legislation under the Ordinance. The Subcommittee was formed to scrutinise the 2016 Regulations. The Subcommittee suggested that the 2016 Regulations make an express provision relating to the requirement that seafarers recruited and placed by an agent to work on board of a ship be given an opportunity to examine and seek advice on their employment agreement before entering into it. The Administration took on board the suggestion and agreed to make the relevant amendment when bringing the 2016 Regulations into operation. To implement such amendment, STH thus makes the Amendment Regulation elaborated in paragraph 8.
- 5. In August 2018, ILO announced that the MLC would come into force in Hong Kong on 20 December 2018.

LEGISLATIVE PROPOSALS

Commencement of the 2013 Ordinance and the 2016 Regulations

- 6. The 14 commencement notices in paragraph 1(a) to (n) seek to bring into operation the provisions in the 2013 Ordinance and 13 pieces of the 2016 Regulations² for implementing the MLC which will come into force in Hong Kong on 20 December 2018.
- 7. The commencement notice in paragraph 1(o) seeks to bring into operation a consequential amendment made to the Schedule to the Administrative Appeals Board Ordinance (Cap. 442), so that a party aggrieved by the decision made by the Seafarers' Authority, i.e. the Director of Marine, under certain provisions in the Merchant Shipping (Seafarers) (Working and Living Conditions) Regulation may appeal to the Administrative Appeals Board.

Amendments to the Merchant Shipping (Seafarers) (Working and Living Conditions) Regulation ("WL Regulation") to incorporate the suggestions of the Subcommittee

8. The MLC requires, amongst other things, that seafarers working on board a ship must have entered into a written employment agreement with the employer and be given an opportunity to examine and seek advice on the agreement before entering into it. This requirement is reflected in the WL Regulation. During the examination of the 2016 Regulations, the Subcommittee suggested and the Administration agreed to

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Out of the 14 pieces of the 2016 Regulations, one of them, namely the Merchant Shipping (Seafarers) (Medical Examination) (Amendment) Regulation 2016, already came into operation on 1 December 2016 for the implementation of the International Convention on Standards of Training, Certification and Watchkeeping for Seafarers in Hong Kong. Thus, there is no need to bring this Regulation into operation in the current legislative exercise.

put the protection beyond doubt by adding to the WL Regulation the requirement that a recruitment agent of seafarers operating in a country that is not a party to the MLC must have measures in place to ensure that the seafarers may examine and seek advice on the employment agreement before entering into it. STH has therefore made the Merchant Shipping (Seafarers) (Working and Living Conditions) (Amendment) Regulation to effect the above requirement. The opportunity is also taken to make a few textual amendments to the WL Regulation to improve its clarity and to rectify a few textual errors.

Consequential amendments to the Merchant Shipping (Seafarers) (Official Log Books) (Amendment) Regulation 2016 ("OLB Amendment Regulation")

- 9. The OLB Amendment Regulation made in May 2016 updated the requirements of official log books kept on vessels as stipulated in the Merchant Shipping (Seafarers) (Official Log Books) Regulation (Cap. 478P) ("the OLB Regulation") for implementing the MLC. Due to the amendments made in December 2016 to the subsidiary legislation under the Merchant Shipping (Safety) Ordinance (Cap. 369), there is a need to introduce consequential amendments to the OLB Regulation to ensure consistency between the two subsidiary legislations given the cross-referencing therein.
- 10. For this purpose, STH has made the Merchant Shipping (Seafarers) (Official Log Books) (Amendment) Regulation 2016 (Amendment) Regulation 2018 to revise certain references in the OLB Regulation.

LEGISLATIVE TIMETABLE

11. The 15 commencement notices and the two amendment regulations will be gazetted on 19 October 2018 and introduced into the LegCo on 24 October 2018 for negative vetting.

IMPLICATIONS OF THE PROPOSAL

12. The proposal has no economic, productivity, competition, financial, family, gender, civil service, environmental or sustainability implications. It is in conformity with the Basic Law, including the provisions concerning human rights. It will not affect the current binding effect of the Ordinance.

PUBLIC CONSULTATION

13. The trade has been informed of the date of the extension of the MLC to Hong Kong and the commencement of the local legislation implementing the MLC. All ships should have already complied with the requirements of MLC.

PUBLICITY

14. A press release will be issued on 19 October 2018. A spokesman will be available to answer enquires.

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Explanatory Note

This Regulation makes amendments to the Merchant Shipping (Seafarers) (Official Log Books) (Amendment) Regulation 2016 (L.N. 75 of 2016) which are consequential to the making of the Merchant Shipping (Safety) (Navigational Equipment and Safety of Navigation) Regulation (Cap. 369 sub. leg. BA) (Safety Regulation). In particular, the amendments aim to—

- (a) include the reference to the Safety Regulation in the Merchant Shipping (Seafarers) (Official Log Books) Regulation (Cap. 478 sub. leg. P); and
- (b) remove the reference to the Merchant Shipping (Safety) (Arrangements for Embarkation and Disembarkation of Pilots) Regulation (Cap. 369 sub. leg. AU), which had been repealed in view of the making of the Safety Regulation.
