INTRODUCTION

The Private Healthcare Facilities Ordinance (Specification of Date for Section 135(1)(a)) Notice and the Private Healthcare Facilities Ordinance (Specification of Date for Section 136(1)(a)) Notice, at <u>Annex</u>, were made by the Director of Health (the Director) under sections 135(6)(a) and 136(6)(a) of the Private Healthcare Facilities Ordinance (Cap. 633, the Ordinance) respectively to specify the dates (the specified dates) in relation to transitional arrangements for existing operators of day procedure centres and clinics.

JUSTIFICATIONS

- 2. The Private Healthcare Facilities Bill was passed by the Legislative Council on 15 November 2018, and the Ordinance was gazetted on 30 November 2018. The Ordinance will further protect patient safety and consumer rights through the introduction of a new regulatory regime for private healthcare facilities.
- 3. As part of the transitional arrangements for the new regulatory regime, the Director must¹, on receiving the operator's application for a full licence², issue a provisional licence to the operator of an existing day procedure centre or an existing clinic that was operated by the operator on the date specified by the Director if the Director is satisfied that certain conditions are met.

Sections 135(6)(a) and 136(6)(a) of the Ordinance respectively provide that the Director may, by notice published in the Gazette, specify the dates with respect to day procedure centres and clinics. The provisional licence allows the day procedure centre or clinic concerned to continue to operate under the new regulatory regime during the transitional period before the day procedure centre or clinic is qualified for a full licence.

4. We consider that given the nature of provisional licence, it would be appropriate to set the specified dates, with respect to both day procedure centres and clinics, as the date on which the Ordinance is gazetted. All persons who operate their day procedure centres or clinics only after the gazettal date of the Ordinance should prepare themselves for the new licensing regime according to the Ordinance, and aim to obtain a full licence once the registration for day procedure centres and clinics begins (tentatively in 2020 and 2021 respectively). The proposed arrangement has been announced in the press release issued on 15 November 2018.³

THE NOTICES

5. Section 1 of the Notice made under section 135(6)(a) of the Ordinance provides that the Notice comes into operation on the day on which section 135 of the Ordinance comes into operation. Similarly, section 1 of the Notice made under section 136(6)(a) of the Ordinance provides that the Notice comes into operation on the day on which section 136 of the Ordinance comes into operation. Sections 2 of the two Notices specify 30 November 2018 as the date for the purposes of sections 135(1)(a) and 136(1)(a) of the Ordinance respectively.
