<b>(A) Amendments relating to occasions on which national anthem (“NA”) must be played and sung (5 in total)</b>			
<b>1</b>	1	Hon CHAN Chi-chuen (1 <sup>st</sup> amendment)	To delete clause 5(2) on the Chief Executive in Council (“CE in Council”) amending Schedule 3 (Occasions on which NA must be played and sung) by notice published in the Gazette.
<b>2</b>	2	Hon Kenneth LEUNG (1 <sup>st</sup> amendment)	To amend clause 5(2) to provide that subject to the approval of the Legislative Council (“LegCo”), CE in Council may, by notice published in the Gazette, amend Schedule 3.
<b>3</b>	3	Hon CHAN Chi-chuen (2 <sup>nd</sup> amendment)	To amend clause 5(2) to provide that CE in Council must not set out the occasion of religious services in Schedule 3.
<b>4</b>	4	Hon CHAN Chi-chuen (3 <sup>rd</sup> amendment)	To add clause 5(5) to provide that before amending Schedule 3, CE in Council must consult the public for not less than three months on the relevant amendment.
<b>5</b>	5	Hon CHAN Chi-chuen (4 <sup>th</sup> amendment)	To add clause 5(5) to provide that for the purposes of clause 7 (Offence of insulting behaviour), calling for not attending or taking part in the occasions on which NA must be played and sung is not regarded as insulting NA.

Inter-dependent and put to vote jointly	6	Hon CHAN Chi-chuen (5 <sup>th</sup> , 6 <sup>th</sup> and 7 <sup>th</sup> amendments)	To delete clauses 6(1)(c) and 6(5) which provide that NA, or its lyrics or score, must not be used on an occasion, at a place, or for a purpose prescribed by CE in Council, and to make corresponding textual amendment to clause 6(1)(b).

7	9	Hon Kenneth LEUNG (2 <sup>nd</sup> amendment)	To amend clause 6(5) to provide that subject to LegCo's approval, CE in Council may, by notice published in the Gazette, prescribe an occasion, place or purpose that NA, or its lyrics or score, must not be used.
<b>(C) Amendments relating to offence of insulting behaviour (5 in total)</b>			
8	10	Hon CHAN Chi-chuen (8 <sup>th</sup> amendment)	To amend clause 7(6) to provide that a person who commits an offence under clause 7 (Offence of insulting behaviour) is liable on conviction to a fine at level 1 (instead of level 5) and to imprisonment for one month (instead of three years).
9	11	Hon Kenneth LEUNG (3 <sup>rd</sup> amendment)	To amend clause 7(6) to provide that a person who commits an offence under clause 7 is liable on conviction to a fine at level 5 but not to imprisonment.
10	12	Hon WU Chi-wai (1 <sup>st</sup> amendment)	To delete clause 7(7) on time limits for commencing proceedings for an offence under clause 7.
11	13	Hon CHAN Chi-chuen (9 <sup>th</sup> amendment)	To amend clause 7(7)(a) to provide that proceedings may only be commenced for an offence under clause 7 before the end of the period of 30 days (instead of one year) after the date on which the offence is discovered by, or comes to the notice of, the Commissioner of Police.

Inter-dependent and put to vote jointly	<b>13</b>	Hon CHAN Chi-chuen (11 <sup>th</sup> , 12 <sup>th</sup> and 13 <sup>th</sup> amendments)	To amend clause 9(1)(b) to add subclause (iii) requiring the Secretary for Education to give directions to educate the students on the biography and cause of death of the lyricist and composer of NA, and to make corresponding textual amendments.
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<b>(E) Amendments relating to inclusion of NA in broadcasting services (3 in total)</b>			
Inter-dependent and put to vote jointly	<b>14</b>	Hon CHAN Chi-chuen (14 <sup>th</sup> and 15 <sup>th</sup> amendments)	To amend clause 10(4) and delete clause 10(5) to provide that regarding the requirement for the licensee to broadcast NA, CE in Council (instead of CE) may, by notice published in the Gazette, stipulate the relevant date.
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<b>15</b>	20	Hon CHAN Chi-chuen (16 <sup>th</sup> amendment)	To amend clause 10(4) to provide that, regarding the Communications Authority's requirement for the licensee to broadcast NA by an announcement in the public interest or material in the public interest, the total number of date or dates so stipulated by CE for relevant broadcast must not be more than 36 days in a calendar year.
<b>(F) Amendment relating to supplementary provisions on application of laws in Hong Kong (1 in total)</b>			
<b>16</b>	21	Hon Alvin YEUNG (1 <sup>st</sup> amendment)	To add clause 11(1A) to provide that the provisions in the National Anthem Ordinance shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with solely the laws of Hong Kong.
