Trade Marks (Amendment) Bill 2019
Debate and voting arrangements

Object of the Bill : To amend the Trade Marks Ordinance to provide for the implementation of an international registration system of trade marks under the Protocol Relating to the Madrid Agreement Concerning the International Registration of Marks; to enhance the mechanism for registering trade marks; to include enforcement powers; and to provide for related or technical amendments.

Clause 15

- To amend clause 15 to add “wilfully” before “obstructs” in the proposed section 96F(2)(a) to clarify that the offence under that provision, which relates to obstructing the exercise of power and performance of duties by an enforcement officer, includes “wilfully” as the mental element.
