#### **Vision 2030 for Rule of Law**



To facilitate an in-depth understanding of the Initiative by Panel members before they have the chance to discuss it and other DoJ's policy initiatives, Dr Hon Priscilla LEUNG Mei-fun, the Panel Chairman, would like you to provide more detailed information regarding DoJ's plans for and action taken so far on the Initiative, preferably in the form of a bilingual information paper to the Panel.
