1. Economic impact of the recent social incidents and changes to external environment on Hong Kong

At the meeting on 18 October 2019, members raised concern about the impact of the recent social incidents and the Hong Kong Human Rights and Democracy Act of 2019 passed by the United States House of Representatives on 15 October 2019 on Hong Kong's economy and the business environment of various industries, in particular SMEs and micro-enterprises. suggested that the Panel should hold a joint meeting with the Panel on Economic Development ("EDEV Panel") and invite the Administration to brief members on the support measures for various industries, as well as the current situation and forecast of Hong Kong's business environment in the midst of the impact of the protests arising from the Fugitive Offenders and Mutual Legal Assistance in Criminal Matters Legislation (Amendment) Bill 2019, the Hong Kong Human Rights and Democracy Act of 2019 and the trade conflict between China and the United States. There was also a view that the Panel might subject to circumstances consider inviting representatives from relevant organizations and major stakeholders of various industries to attend the proposed joint meeting and give views on the related subjects.

Chairman of EDEV Panel has agreed to hold the proposed joint meeting. At its meeting on 18 October 2019, EDEV Panel also suggested that the Panel on Financial Affairs ("FA Panel") and the Panel on Information Technology and Broadcasting ("ITB Panel") be invited to hold the proposed joint meeting and discuss the related subjects. The suggestion was subsequently agreed by Chairmen of these two Panels. The proposed joint meeting will be held by the four Panels.
