Head 701 Subhead 1100CA

The project estimate under Head 701 Subhead 1100CA in respect of the item on Hong Kong section of Guangzhou-Shenzhen-Hong Kong Express Rail Link (XRL) is \$1,731.121M. The amount of compensation reserved is for payment of various compensation arising from land acquisition, land clearance and temporary occupation of land. The annual cash flow requirement for an individual item is assessed based on the progress of negotiation in respect of compensation claims under the item. Once agreement on the amount of compensation has been reached with a claimant in accordance with the legal provisions, the ruling of the Lands Tribunal or the administrative arrangements of the ex-gratia allowances as approved by the Finance Committee, the Lands D will pay the claimant compensation or fees, together with the interest thereon if applicable. Up to end of October 2019, the cumulative expenditure of the compensation payment of the XRL project under Head 701 subhead 1100CA is \$1,531.745M. The scope and details of the expenditure involved are as follows:
