Action

I. Election of Chairman (and Deputy Chairman)

The Subcommittee deliberated (index of proceedings attached at Annex).

2. <u>Mr LEUNG Yiu-chung</u>, member who had the highest precedence in Council among members of the Subcommittee present, presided over the election of Chairman. <u>Mr LEUNG</u> recapitulated that members' views on whether candidates should be given time to present their election platforms were sought at the last Subcommittee meeting on 28 April 2020. As some members had not yet given their views, the discussion would continue at this meeting.

3. <u>Mr IP Kin-yuen, Mr Charles MOK, Dr Helena WONG</u> and <u>Mr CHAN</u> <u>Chi-chuen</u> considered it necessary to conduct election platforms, during which candidates should explain their proposals on conducting meetings in a fair and open manner, and meeting schedule in order to cover all the issues proposed in the work plan given the limited time left in the current legislative session. <u>Mr IP</u> held the view that the prevailing textbook review mechanism had been effective. The candidates should give their views on whether the Administration should tighten the control over the development of textbooks and teaching materials. Dr WONG considered that the candidates should also inform members of their relevant experience in leading the Subcommittee to discuss the development of textbooks and teaching materials for kindergartens, primary and secondary schools. <u>Mr CHAN</u> considered that candidates should also explain how to collect teaching materials for discussion, including whether the schools or teachers concerned would be invited to the Subcommittee meeting(s).

4. <u>Mr LEUNG Che-cheung, Ms Elizabeth QUAT</u> and <u>Ms YUNG Hoi-yan</u> urged Mr LEUNG Yiu-chung to proceed directly to the election of Chairman. <u>Mr LEUNG</u> said he would consider issuing a letter to the Chairman of the Panel on Education to disqualify Mr LEUNG Yiu-chung from presiding the election. In view of the many complaints from parents about the incorrect and biased textbooks and teaching materials, <u>Ms QUAT</u> considered there was a need to review and improve the mechanisms for developing textbooks and teaching materials.

5. <u>Mr CHAN Chi-chuen</u> said that the Subcommittee might collect teaching materials for discussion through different means such as from the Internet, parents and schools. He enquired whether members would be protected by the Legislative Council (Powers and Privileges) Ordinance (Cap. 382) if the teaching materials for discussion were later found to be inauthentic. <u>Mr LEUNG Yiu-chung</u> advised that he would follow up Mr CHAN's concern with the Legal Advisor to the Subcommittee after the meeting.

6. <u>Ms YUNG Hoi-yan</u> said that the Subcommittee could hold a public hearing to receive views and collect teaching materials from parents and students. In her view, it might not be necessary for the Subcommittee to ensure the authenticity of the textbooks or teaching materials obtained.
