I. Election of Chairman and Deputy Chairman for the 2019-2020 session

Election of Chairman

Mr IP Kin-yuen, the incumbent Chairman, invited nominations for the chairmanship of the Panel on Education ("the Panel"). <u>Dr CHIANG Lai-wan</u> nominated Mrs Regina IP and the nomination was seconded by <u>Ms YUNG Hoi-yan.</u> <u>Mrs Regina IP</u> accepted the nomination.

- 2. <u>Ms Claudia MO</u> nominated Mr IP Kin-yuen and the nomination was seconded by <u>Ms Tanya CHAN</u>. <u>Mr IP Kin-yuen</u> accepted the nomination.
- 3. <u>Mr Vincent CHENG</u>, the incumbent Deputy Chairman, took the chair and invited further nominations. There was no other nomination. <u>Dr Helena WONG</u> suggested that the two candidates be given time to present their election platforms. <u>Mrs Regina IP</u> and <u>Mr IP Kin-yuen</u> made their respective presentations.
- 4. <u>Mr Vincent CHENG</u> proceeded with the election and announced a vote by secret ballot. After all members had cast their votes, <u>Mr CHENG</u> invited Dr CHIANG Lai-wan and Ms Claudia MO who had made the nominations to oversee the counting of votes. Of the members present for voting, 26 voted for Mrs Regina IP and 11 voted for Mr IP Kin-yuen. <u>Mr CHENG</u> declared Mrs Regina IP elected as Chairman of the Panel. <u>Mrs Regina IP</u> then took the chair.

Election of Deputy Chairman

5. <u>The Chairman</u> invited nominations for the deputy chairmanship of the Panel. <u>Dr Helena WONG</u> nominated Mr IP Kin-yuen and the nomination was seconded by <u>Ms Tanya CHAN</u>. <u>Mr IP Kin-yuen</u> accepted the nomination. As

there was no other nomination, <u>the Chairman</u> declared Mr IP Kin-yuen elected as Deputy Chairman of the Panel.

II. Schedule of meetings for the 2019-2020 session

6. <u>The Deputy Chairman</u> suggested holding regular Panel meetings on Mondays to Thursdays so as to get more media coverage on Panel discussion. <u>The Chairman</u> directed the Secretariat to identify alternative timeslot(s) and consult members on their preferred timeslot after the meeting.

Policy briefing-cum-regular meeting on 1 November 2019

7. <u>Members</u> agreed to receive a briefing by the Secretary for Education ("SED") on the relevant policy initiatives in the Chief Executive's 2019 Policy Address, and discuss the provision of a subsidy to day-school students proposed by the Administration at the next regular meeting on Friday, 1 November 2019 at 10:45 am.

<u>Items for discussion at future meetings</u>

- 8. <u>Ms Tanya CHAN</u> urged for early discussion of item 2 on the "List of outstanding items for discussion" ("the List"), i.e. Governance of University Grants Committee-funded institutions and proposed Members' Bill to amend the University of Hong Kong Ordinance (Cap. 1053); and proposed the Panel to discuss the implementation of sex education in schools.
- 9. <u>Mr HO Kai-ming</u> and <u>Dr Priscilla LEUNG</u> urged for early discussion of item 7 on the List, i.e. Review of the New Senior Secondary curriculum and assessment, in particular implementation of the Liberal Studies ("LS") subject.

<u>Dr LEUNG</u> also suggested holding a meeting to receive public views on LS subject.

- 10. <u>Ms Claudia MO</u> reiterated her request for discussion of item 25 on the List, i.e. Teaching and learning of English language.
- 11. <u>Mr CHAN Chi-chuen</u> considered it necessary for the Education Bureau to brief the Panel on the relevant guidelines, if any, to assist schools in dealing with students who were arrested/injured in the protests arising from Fugitive Offenders Bill. He also proposed the Panel to follow up on the impact of the Prohibition on Face Covering Regulation on students and schools.
- 12. <u>Mr Vincent CHENG</u> suggested the Panel to arrange a sharing session for the delegation to Finland to share with Panel members the information and experience acquired during the visit in September 2019.
- 13. The Chairman said that she and the Deputy Chairman would meet with SED to discuss the work plan of the Panel for the current session. She invited members to notify her or the Clerk if they wished to raise any items for discussion at future meetings. She would then convey members' views to SED at the meeting.

IV. Any other business

- 14. <u>Members</u> noted that starting from October 2019 in the 2019-2020 session, simultaneous sign language interpretation service would be provided to all regular and special meetings of the Panel. The service would not cover any subcommittee on policy issues formed under the Panel and would only be provided on a need and request basis for joint meetings involving the Panel.
- 15. There being no other business, the meeting ended at 11:30 am.
