Follow-up to the meeting on 3 January 2020

I refer to your letter of 6 January 2020 to the Secretary for Education. The supplementary information on the “Partial redevelopment and conversion of the Hong Kong Chinese Women's Club College at 2B, Tai Cheong Street, Sai Wan Ho” (i.e. Project 8095EB) as requested by the Panel on Education is set out as follows:

Generally speaking, capital grant provided by the Government to schools for works project is calculated based on the standard provision for public sector schools. For above-standard and non-standard facilities, they will be funded by School Sponsoring Body. Insofar as Project 8095EB is concerned, all facilities to be provided under the scope are standard provision. This project will therefore be fully subvented by the Government after obtaining funding approval from the Finance Committee of the Legislative Council. As understood from the Hong Kong Chinese Women's Club College, the School had once explored ways to raise the required funding should non-standard facilities be added under Project 8095EB. As the School has eventually decided that non-standard facilities would not be required under


